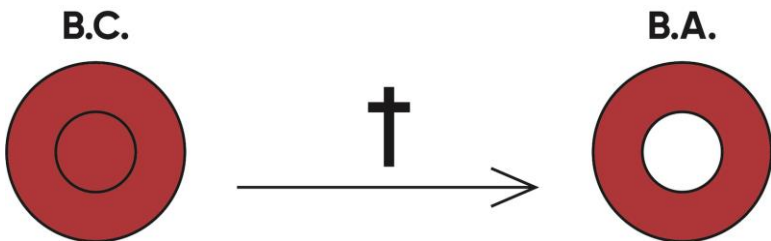
What do we learn from *Romans 1:16*?

What does it mean to be "*freed from sin*"? (v. 7)

- Freedom from the power of sin.

- Freedom from the penalty of sin.

- But not freedom from the presence of sin.

Some Christians have a difficult time believing they are "free".

1. Haven't been taught

2. Satan doesn't want you to know

3. Re-creation was non-experiential

4. Fury of the conflict with sin in the "flesh" makes us wonder if we are really free
